## Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for students with disabilities

Guidelines for Scribe: PwD candidates may avail the services of a scribe at the time of appearing for the offline examination as per the terms mentioned below, which are as per the guidelines issued by Government of India.

- (i) The visually impaired candidates and candidates whose writing speed is adversely affected permanently for any reason can use their own scribe at their cost during the offline examination, subject to limits as in (ii) and (iii) below. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply:
  - · The candidate will have to arrange his/her own scribe at his/her own cost.
  - The scribe arranged by the examinee should not be a candidate for the same level of
    examination. If violation of the above is detected at any stage of the process, candidature of
    both the examinee and the scribe will be cancelled. Candidates eligible for and who wish to use
    the services of a scribe in the examination should invariably carefully indicate the same in his
    application form. Any subsequent request may not be favourably entertained.
  - · A person acting as scribe for one candidate can not be a scribe for another candidate.
  - · The scribe may be from any academic stream.
  - Both the candidate as well as scribe will have to give an affidavit and undertaking form
    confirming that the scribe fulfills all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe mentioned
    above. Further in case it later transpires that he/she did not fulfill any laid down eligibility
    criteria or suppressed material facts, the candidature of the examinee will stand cancelled,
    irrespective of the result of the examination.
  - Those candidates who use a scribe shall be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination or as otherwise advised.
  - For online examinations, Only candidates registered for compensatory time will be allowed such concessions since compensatory time given to candidates shall be system based, it shall not be possible for the test conducting agency to allow such time if he / she is not registered for the same. Candidates not registered for compensatory time shall not be allowed such concessions.
- (ii) Guidelines for Candidates with Locomotor Disability and Cerebral Palsy: Compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour or otherwise advised shall be permitted for the candidates with Locomotor Disability and cerebral palsy where dominant (writing) extremity is affected to the extent of slowing the performance of function (minimum of 40% impairment).

### (iii) Guidelines for Visually Impaired candidates:

- Visually Impaired candidates (who suffer from not less than 40% of disability)mayopt to view the contents of the test in magnified font and all such candidates will be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour or otherwise advised of examination.
- The facility of viewing the contents of the test in magnifying font will not be available to Visually Impaired candidates who use the services of a Scribe for the examination.
